The Purchaser agrees to the terms of the deposit of \$_____ on the date of the signing of this contract. The remaining balance of \$_____ will be paid on the arrival and set up on the date of the event mentioned above. This fee is for ____ hours of service. Additional hours of service may be purchased for the amount of \$_____/hour. In the unfortunate event of a cancelation from the purchaser, half of the deposit may be refundable. The client agrees to all responsibilities of reimbursement of any equipment damaged at the clients event. The client is required to provide four power outlets and a shelter from earthly elements such as, and not inclusive to (rain, snow, wind, hail, sun). Summer Nights Entertainment agrees to be set up and ready by the agreed upon time. The DJ will be dressed according to theme or colors of the event in a button down shirt, tie and dress slacks or polo shirt, any special required dress code will be accommodated with a special fee. The service includes music, lighting, and special master of ceremonies, additional services will be available for a special fee. If the location of the venue changes, the DJ asks to provide a two weeks notice. The DJ and Summer Nights Entertainment is not responsible for accidents or injury to guests due to dancing at the event. Any changes to this contract will be agreed upon and signed by both parties involved. If special alterations to any song is required, the DJ can preview said song with the client, once the song is agreed upon the DJ is not responsible for any other changes to the music.
